## 1 OVERVIEW

The scorecards produced by Crick Kit scorecard follow the following standard conventions.

## 2 BATSMEN STATISTICS

### 2.1 Runs

Runs awarded to the batsman. Does not include extras accumulated while batsman is at the crease

## **2.2 Balls Faced**

Balls faced by the batsman. Does not include wides.

## **2.3 4's**

Number of 4's awarded to batsmen.

## **2.4 6's**

Number of 6's awarded to batsman

## **2.5 Strike Rate**

Average number of runs scored per 100 balls faced

# **3 BOWLERS STATISTICS**

## **3.1 Overs**

Number of overs bowled by bowler. If an over is incomplete it will still show up as an over bowled by the bowler in this statistic

## **3.2 Maidens**

Number of overs that resulted in the bowler not conceding any runs/extras (any byes or leg byes are not counted as being conceded by the bowler)

## **3.3 Runs**

Number of runs/extras conceded by the bowler (any byes or leg byes are not counted as being conceded by the bowler)

## **3.4 Wickets**

Number of wickets taken by the bowler

# **4 EXTRAS**

## **4.1 Byes**

Byes conceded.

## **4.2 Leg Byes**

Leg Byes conceded.

## **4.3 No Ball**

Extras attributed to No Balls. Includes initial penalty and any extras (not runs) scored

off No Balls.

#### **4.4 Wides**

Extras attributed to Wides. Includes initial penalty and any extras scored off Wides.

#### **4.5 Penalties**

Any miscellaneous extras conceded.
